



## **Birding And Burgers Outing**

**Description:** This is a joint offering of Payne County Audubon Society and the Cimarron Group of the Sierra Club. Activities will include a guided morning bird walk followed by a backyard cookout lunch. Afternoon activities include a fishing derby and a plant walk.

**Number of Participants:** There is no group limit, but advance registration is necessary to join in the lunch.

**Camping:** Participants are welcome to arrive Friday night and camp in a pecan grove on Little Stillwater Creek on the host's property.

### **Activity Details:**

At 9:00 a.m. OSU's Dr. Tim O'Connell will lead the group in looking for migrant species plus our favorite locals. Tim teaches ornithology and is President of the Oklahoma Ornithological Society.

Lunch will be served on site, with hot burgers, chips, drinks and a dessert. The afternoon will be devoted to your choice of a fall plant

walkabout or a brief fishing derby to see who can land the largest bass.

**Directions to Meeting Point:** Beginning at the intersection of Jardot and 6<sup>th</sup> ST (OK 51) on the east side of Stillwater, go 6.3 miles east. Look for a left turn lane and a small street sign on the left that says Old Highway 51. Turn left and proceed NE about 1/2 mile. The entry will be the 3<sup>rd</sup> drive on your left after turning onto Old 51. The address is 204 N Old Highway 51.

- Food for Saturday morning if camping
